Yard of the month: Ronda to pick for April

Old Business:

- Easter Egg hunt— Erika and Aldo planning. To be held in the playground area. Erika to check with the lawn company to make sure the grass is mowed. Aldo to send out a reminder email to residents. Erika to buy treats and eggs and submit receipt for reimbursement.
- > Maintenance list—The following needs to be addressed:
 - Flag replacement (wait for tree removal, see landscaping plans)
 - o Electrical cable fix behind the wall

- 90-degree extension for the water faucet
- Re-installation of rules sign
- Flood light replacement with theft protection
- Front landscaping and beautification Landscaping team has come up with a plan for the lawn maintenance crew. The quote came in at \$2400 which is still under budget. The list of items include:
 - Tree trimming along the retention pond area, around the flagpole area and the small tree removal of tree that is interfering with the flag.
 - Clean out tree seedlings in long grass in flagpole area
 - o Remove all dead bushes and level the area and lay new grass in the flagpole area
 - At the front entrance: lay down red mulch, plant purple and white flowers, plant 3 agave plants around the trees
 - Area across from flagpole area: red mulch around all trees, red and yellow flowers, agaves between trees along detention pond area
 - Flagpole area: red mulch around all trees and plant area, move shrubs from across the street to fill in area with no shrubs on left side to even out shrubs, 3 agave plants evenly spaced, rest of area filled in thick with red and white flowers.
- ➤ Playground progress The following items discussed:
 - Picnic table installation in NE corner-Maintenance team to look into
 - o Potted flowers-decided not to do this due to risk of damage
 - Cameras for playground discussed Still need to address this, assigned to Aldo. Marie had some examples to look at including a website and an example from Academy
 - o Thank you notes to the MUD board Encourage signing these at the Easter egg hunt in a few weeks.
 - O Playground rules sign Sign needs to be redone with the words swings in place of slides. Ronda to take care of. Two additional "Play at your own risk" signs are being added.
