He was informed that the police were called out several times for him and even though he seems to leave just before they get there, he will be arrested and sent to jail.

As these individuals continue to be seen more and more often, and this is becoming a huge safety concern to our children and our residents on the walking trails and in the playground.

It is NOT RECOMMENDED to approach these individuals as you don't know if they are carrying any type of weapon, so It is important that we take care of these types of incidents as soon as they are seen, otherwise our trails may have homeless people and drug-users moving in if it is not stopped right-away.

The HOA board asked for everyone to be vigilant.

If you should see suspicious individuals like this, if possible, take pictures and forward them to the board.
