Homeless Sleeping on Front Entrance Lawn – Reported by a nearby homeowner. There was an unknown homeless person reported sleeping on the front entrance lawn. Apparently, this person was seen there sleeping for several hours. Pictures were taken and sent to a board member for a crime awareness report.

Unfortunately, the Sheriff's office was not contacted by the homeowner taking the pictures and by the time the board member received the pictures it was after the fact.

The HOA board has been doing a lot of things to deter homeless from going on our common property or front entrance, but it doesn't seem to make a lot of difference. The Sheriff's office needs to be contacted right away, otherwise there is no way to deter these incidents from continuing. We are looking for suggestions from residents, so please let us know your thoughts by sending an email to the WOS HOA board email below.

This is UNSAFE for all our residents, but mostly our kids playing in the nearby playground and our trail walkers, so if possible, please take pictures, and, immediately call the non-emergency Sheriff's number below and please ask that the deputy that goes out phone you back to let you know what they did find or did as we'd like to know. And email the HOA Board the pictures and feedback so we can add a crime awareness report.

THIS IS IMPORTANT, don't just do nothing, if you see homeless persons settling down in our community, please contact the non-emergency Sheriff's number below and request that they be removed immediately. Homeless persons are constantly seen in our community, and we need to nip-it-in-the bud, for everyone's safety and for our own property values.
